e-Book: Analysing Includate Communities

This digital resource, enriched with visual elements and interactive maps, was developed by mapping and analysing local migrant communities in Budapest, Gdynia, Palermo, Berlin, and Copenhagen. The e-Book presents the needs, challenges, and capacities of these communities, helping local stakeholders better understand the role of people with a migrant background and their expectations for inclusion.
